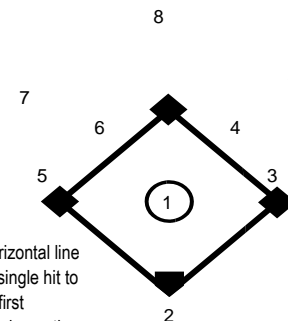
**EXAMPLES:**

**Fielding position numbers:**

- 1 Pitcher
- 2 Catcher
- 3 First Base
- 4 Second Base
- 5 Third Base
- 6 Shortstop
- 7 Left Field
- 8 Centre Field
- 9 Right Field



**Note:** If a team uses more than 9 fielders just use a small letter **a** to show the extra positions, (eg, 7a is the extra leftfielder, 8a is the extra centre fielder). Players who bat only are marked as position B.

**INFO:** Going **down** the inning column, mark the advance of the players around the bases, or out. Fill in runs made. When 3 outs are made or side retires, rule off the column with a diagonal line and horizontal line into next column to the right (see sample). When the team is up again, move to column on the right, and begin at the square for the next batter up. Scorers may wish to mark hit locations, eg. -4 means single hit to second base fielder, =9 means double base hit to right fielder, or you can use the simple method of advancing runners. The outs can show the fielders involved. Eg. 5-3 means third baseman threw to first baseman; F8 means centrefielder caught a fly ball; UA3 means first base made the out unassisted (nobody threw to him). Strikeouts are marked with a K in the first square. At the bottom of the inning column, the runs for the inning go above the diagonal line, and the running total for the game goes below.
